Useful Show Tent Tips!

Floral Art

- Floral Art arrangements displayed in water retaining material, make sure container strong enough
 - Materials may be bought.

Flowers

- To be fresh, fully open and blemish free
- Choose your vase well in proportion to your flowers

Fruit and Veg

- Veg to be clean and disease free!
- Courgettes can be shown with or without the flowers
 - Cauliflowers to have leaves cut back

Cooking, preserves and drinks

- Jams and jellies to be sealed with plain lid, or waxed disc and clear film top
 - Make sure all jars are full to the top.
- Liqueurs in plain glass bottle with easily removable cork or stopper

Cakes and breads

- For baking please no packet mixes and no item to be displayed in the container in which it was cooked
 - All cooked entries must be covered in cling film.
- To avoid rack marks on cakes, turn out of tin and put onto greaseproof paper on rack

Photography Section

- Photos may be digitally enhanced, but not manipulated.
 - Maximum size – 7-inch x 5 inch
 - Please don't mount photos
